

Can I put lockers in the bedroom

You can see in the picture below, how I trimmed out each locker. I used 1x2 pine wood to create a framed border inside each locker space. I put an ARB in the rear, so use that most of the time. Only use the front when absolutely necessary. The rear is a D44 so is worth building unlike the front D30.
