Strictly speaking, Chinese four-character collocations cannot completely be the same as idioms, since the latter still has five-character collocations or even six or seven characters. However, most of the idioms we use today are the four-character ones. So, the present paper focuses on the four-character collocations from the idioms' perspective.

As Korean intellectuals like to quote four-character idioms, a new word is in the making. For example, at the end of 2020, a group of professors devised a brand-new four-character idiom 2020年(2020年), literally meaning "I'm right, but you're wrong", to characterize the phenomena during the year of 2020 in a word.

English translations of yojijukugo include "four-character compound", "four-character idiom", "four-character idiomatic phrase", and "four-character idiomatic compound". Each kanji has meaning one by one, but by enriching the four-character idiom, further enrich the expression. Enjoy the beautiful expression of Japan.
