

Hand-pull photovoltaic panels on the roof

The building integrated roof mounting PV (BIPV) panels were installed within a few hours, ready for the tilers to fit the adjoining tiles and crack on with the rest of their work. Hooking up the electrics and installing the smart batteries, EV charging etc will be completed as part of the first and second fix work.

Wind lift: It's important to consider wind lift - you don't want the panels flying off on a windy day. Air will flow through the gap between the solar panels and the roof will cause some uplift. This is why the hooks that attach the panels to the roof need to be fixed to a sturdy structure to avoid them ripping away.

When installing Solar panels on a flat roof, this is easily achieved. As the Solar Panels are installed onto a bracket which tilts the panel to around 30 degrees. Flat Roof Solar panels are usually mounted onto a tub, and weighed down by ballast (gravel, paving slabs, bricks, rocks etc) in order to resist high winds.
