

# How big a photovoltaic panel should be installed on the roof

What size roof do I need to install solar panels?

In terms of roof size, you will need a roof of around 20 square metres to install 10 panels on average. But please bear in mind that you will need to consult the assistance of a solar panel installer to get a more accurate idea. Should you install small or large solar panels?

How long should a solar panel be on a roof?

Panels should never extend beyond the edge of the roof as the wind can be stronger there. To keep your property safe, and to abide by MCS regulations, we try to maintain a margin of 30 cm around the panels. What is the size of a solar panel? In recent years solar panels have become smaller but more efficient.

How many solar panels do I need?

The number and size of your solar panels depend on the size of your property and energy demands. A 4kW solar system is one of the most popular sizes for domestic solar systems, as it is typically appropriate for homes with 3 to 4 people. So in this case, you'd need something like 10 solar panels installed on your roof, each at a power of 400 W.
