Stop Wasting Energy: Things We Can All Do. More people are taking action to reduce light pollution and bring back the natural night sky. Many states have adopted legislation to control outdoor lighting, and manufacturers have designed and produced high-efficiency light sources that save energy and reduce light pollution.

Definition of light pollution. Light pollution is the human-made alteration of outdoor light levels from those occurring naturally. When we over-light, fail to use timers and sensors, or use the wrong color of light, we can negatively affect many parts of our world, including migratory birds, pollinators, sea turtles, and mammals, including humans.

If you want to escape light pollution and experience a truly dark sky, go where the pros go. The World Atlas of Artificial Sky Brightness, first compiled in 2000 and updated in 2016, shows that most major professional observatories in the world lie in black spots, meaning their sky is almost as dark as it was when humans first started lighting up the night.

This comes at a massive cost to the health of people in energy poverty: indoor air pollution, ... No electricity means no refrigeration of food; no washing machine or dishwasher; and no light at night. You might have seen the photos of children sitting under a street lamp at night to do their homework. 7.

As stated in the National Geographic article Our Vanishing Night [1], light pollution is largely the effects of bad lighting design, which allows artificial light to shine outward and upward into the sky, where it's not wanted, instead of focusing it downward, where it is.
