Do solar PV panels need to be cleaned?

How to clean a solar panel?

Many cleaning products are too abrasive for solar panels or may leave a residue that blocks sunlight, so you should choose these carefully. Try mixing a mild detergent in water, slowly adding more cleaner if you need more cleaning power. The last step in solar panel cleaning is to dry the glass and review your work.

How often should you wash solar panels?

While some suggest that regularly washing panels is necessary to get the maximum solar conversion possible. Others feel that solar panels should only get a rinse off once in a while if you see a notably low solar output.
