

What energy storage technology does Japan use?

In terms of energy storage technology, Japan is supported primarily by pumped hydro and by NaS and Li-ion battery storage capability, according to the US Department of Energy.⁸⁸ While Japan is the world leader in NaS battery energy storage technology, it is also the world's second manufacturer of Pb-Acid energy storage systems.

Japan is targeting net zero emissions from its economy by 2050, with an interim target of getting to between 36% and 38% renewable energy on the grid by 2030. To get to that target, the Japanese government has recently re-prioritised its focus on decarbonisation of the power sector to include energy storage as well as renewable energy generation.

Last month, Hitachi Zosen announced an agreement with the Japan Aerospace Exploration Agency to test its solid-state batteries in space. The company's battery will power camera equipment in Japan's Kibo module on the ISS. The Japanese solid-state battery could leave our atmosphere as early as fall and will be tested for six months.
