Do parrots need a cage?

a. Adequate Space: Parrots require a spacious cage that allows them to move, stretch their wings, and exercise. The size of the cage should be appropriate for your parrot's species and size. As a general guideline, larger parrots, such as macaws or cockatoos, need larger cages compared to smaller parrot species like budgies or lovebirds.

How do you care for a parrot's cage?

Avoid leaving your parrot in a chilly room or dropping your thermostat overnight during winter. Temperatures below 40 degrees can be dangerous for birds, especially thin ones.
