Can I use a hose to remove snow from my solar panels?

If it is very cold outside we highly suggest that you do not use a hose to clean the snow off of your solar panels. If you like to minimize labor, you can install a warm water line or heater for snow removal. These will heat your solar panels up and melt all the snow covering them.

Can you use a broom to sweep snow off solar panels?

Similar to a roof rake, a soft-bristled outdoor broom can be used to sweep the snow off the solar panels. Opt for a broom with soft bristles and a telescoping handle to reach high points of the roof, and sweep the snow and ice off the solar panels. Be careful not to scratch the surface. For light, fluffy snow, a leaf blower can be effective.
