

Solar Farm Goats

Can goats be used for solar grazing?

Goats are not suitable for solar grazing due to their tendency to chew on wires, climb on panels, and cause mischief. Some sites may have panels on taller posts, allowing cows to graze the site, but this is rare. Goats are not an appropriate choice for solar grazing. What does it take to be a solar grazer? What questions should you ask yourself before getting into it?

Is solar grazing beneficial for a sheep farm?

Solar grazing can be beneficial for a sheep farm as it allows the sheep to be off-farm for much of the season, which may provide the opportunity to stockpile forage or make hay, saving on feed costs. Sheep farmers can still market all their lambs at the end of the season.
