In South Sudan, the 20 MWp solar project under development near the capital Juba has two new players. They are the photovoltaic system supplier Asunim Solar, based in the United Arab Emirates, and the renewable energy solutions consultancy company I-kWh. The two companies join Elsewedy Electric, which was awarded the solar project in December 2019.

Elsewedy Electric has signed a contract with South Sudan's Ministry of Energy and Dams to construct hybrid solar and storage system valued at approximately \$45 million. The project will be built on a 250,000 square meter site near Nesitu county, 20 kilometres from the capital city of Juba, and is expected to begin operations in 2020.
