Who owns State Grid?

As of March 2024, State Grid is the world's third largest company overall by revenue, behind Walmart and Amazon. In 2023 it was reported as having 1.3 million employees, 1.1 billion customers and revenue equivalent to US\$546 billion. It is overseen by the State-owned Assets Supervision and Administration Commission of the State Council.

What is China's State Grid?

China's State Grid, one of the country's two grid operators, proposed the technology to the government in 2004 to connect the country's hydro and coal power stations with the economic hubs that gobbled electricity hundreds of miles away.

How will the state grid increase and stabilize the power supply?

The State Grid will increase and stabilize the power supply by tapping the potential of all kinds of resources, while closely tracking the thermal coal and gas supply, and coordinating power transmission across different regions to ensure the safety of the grid, said Meng Haijun, spokesperson with the State Grid.

After the electricity Plant-Grid Separation reform in early 2002, the assets of State Electric Power Corporation (?????) were divided into five power generation groups that retained the power plants and five regional subsidiaries belonging to the State Grid Corporation of China in Beijing.

What percentage of China's power grid is SGCC?

SGCC accounts for 80% of the Chinese grid, with China Southern Power Grid accounting for the other 20%. : 40 At its creation, SGCC company had a generation capacity of 6.47 gigawatts. In 2003 and progressively so through the early 2000s, electrical shortages caused the government to institute rolling blackouts.

When was the State Grid Corporation of China founded?

The State Grid Corporation of China was founded on December 29, 2002, when the restructuring divided the former State Power Corporation of China into two grid companies, five generation groups and four accessory business companies.
