CIGS solar panels are much more expensive to produce than CdTe or amorphous silicon. The overall cost of a thin-film solar panel installation is usually lower than a monocrystalline or polycrystalline solar installation. Thin-film solar panel installations are less labor-intensive because the panels are lighter and more maneuverable.

A 3.5 kWp solar panel system would typically require around 10 solar panels (at 350 W each) and cost between \$5,000 and \$10,000. *kWp stands for "kilowatt peak". This is the amount of power that a solar panel or array will ...

If the sun shines on a solar panel with a 20% efficiency rating, 20% of the sun's energy will convert to solar energy in ideal conditions. Given the same amount of sunlight shining simultaneously on two equal-sized solar panels with different efficiency ratings, the more efficient panel will produce more power than the less efficient panel.
