What are base year costs for utility-scale battery energy storage systems?

Base year costs for utility-scale battery energy storage systems (BESS) are based on a bottom-up cost model using the data and methodology for utility-scale BESS in (Ramasamy et al., 2021). The bottom-up BESS model accounts for major components, including the LIB pack, inverter, and the balance of system (BOS) needed for the installation.

How much does battery storage cost?

The costs of installing and operating large-scale battery storage systems in the United States have declined in recent years. Average battery energy storage capital costs in 2019 were \$589 per kilowatt-hour (kWh), and battery storage costs fell by 72% between 2015 and 2019, a 27% per year rate of decline.

How much energy does a battery storage system use?

The average for the long-duration battery storage systems was 21.2 MWh, between three and five times more than the average energy capacity of short- and medium-duration battery storage systems. When will large-scale battery energy storage systems come online?

Most large-scale battery energy storage systems we expect to come online in the United States over the next three years are to be built at power plants that also produce electricity from solar photovoltaics, a change in trend from recent years.

Which states have the most small-scale battery storage power capacity?

In 2019, 402 MW of small-scale total battery storage power capacity existed in the United States. California accounts for 83% of all small-scale battery storage power capacity. The states with the most small-scale power capacity outside of California include Hawaii, Vermont, and Texas.

What is the average power capacity of a battery storage system?

For costs reported between 2013 and 2019, short-duration battery storage systems had an average power capacity of 12.4 MW, medium-duration systems had 6.4 MW, and long-duration battery storage systems had 4.7 MW. The average energy capacity for the short- and medium-duration battery storage systems were 4.7 MWh and 6.6 MWh, respectively.

Texas, with an expected 6.4 GW, and California, with an expected 5.2 GW, will account for 82% of the new U.S. battery storage capacity. Developers have scheduled the Menifee Power Bank (460.0 MW) at the site of the former Inland Empire Energy Center natural gas-fired power plant in Riverside, California, to come on line in 2024.

The first phase of the 10MW demonstration power station passed the grid connection acceptance and was officially connected to the grid for power generation. This marked the world's first salt cave advanced compressed air power station. The energy storage power station has entered a state of formal commercial operation.

On November 16, Fujian GW-level Ningde Xiapu Energy Storage Power Station (Phase I) of State Grid Times successfully transmitted power. The project is mainly invested by State Grid Integrated Energy and CATL, which is the largest single grid-side standalone station-type electrochemical energy storage power station in China so far.

300 MWh is perhaps big or even "huge" for a battery storage but not generally for storing energy. 300 MWh is about the energy that a typical nuclear power plant delivers in 20 minutes.
