The mounting system will vary depending on the type of roof, such as flat, pitched, or shingle roofs. Common mounting methods include roof attachments, roof hooks, or solar panel racking systems. The mounting system should be securely fastened to the roof structure to ensure the stability and longevity of the solar panel installation.

Generally, roof mounted systems are less expensive than ground mounted systems, because the main structure needed to sustain the panels is the rooftop itself. This saves costs that otherwise would rise higher due to the aluminum or steel structures needed to support ground mounted panels. Solar panel installation suitable for sloped roof

Suppose, in our case the load is 3000 Wh/per day. To know the needed total W Peak of a solar panel capacity, we use PFG factor i.e. Total W Peak of PV panel capacity = $3000 / 3.2$ (PFG) = 931 W Peak. Now, the required number of PV panels are = $931 / 160W = 5.8$. This way, we need 6 numbers of solar panels each rated for 160W.
